Inserting Raster Images GP4, CAL, TIF etc. into Autocad..txt

Many of these files are scanned raster image files (.TIF,.CAL, .GP4) so please see below for instructions on viewing these files.

If you open your Autocad program and go to 'insert' on the menu bar and then go to 'raster' image you will then be able to browse for the .GP4 or .CAL file.

Make sure the scale is set to 1 (you will need to uncheck the 'specify on screen' box here) then click ok.

Click on the location where you want to place the image and that's it. You can now view and scale the image and print it out from Autocad.
