




Vocational School, Vienna




This **Vocational School** was designed for a site in the north of Vienna, where both the block structure and the pattern of development have become fragmented. In its program and architecture, the proposal is conceived as a vehicle for meeting the needs of the surrounding area. The built volumes are positioned around the edge of a large open space, whose lower surface is divided into two sections by a change of level. The classrooms for practical lessons are located at either end of the building, whilst the classrooms for teaching theory are contained in the two-storey elements which bridge over the sports area.

Urban Plan Vienna North – an urbanistic design as a hypothetical city scenario – was to prepare the public for the entirely new situation the city was to face after the political changes in the east/north and focus attention on the chance to turn Vienna into an important Central European metropolis. That would have meant a new exhibition centre complying with international standards located near the city's Donaupark in front of the United Nations buildings; a densely built new quarter between the city centre and the Danube river.




Urban Plan Vienna North






Government Centre, Spreebogen, Berlin




For the project **Government Centre Spreebogen in Berlin** we took a radical step and broke with the scale of the city centre. We wanted to find a relevant form for the new capital by creating an interaction between the two extremes, the void of the site (Tiergarten district) and the intensity of urban life. A 520 x 310 x 14m platform suspended 35 metres above the ground was to span the area of the existing Reichstag building and rest upon three high-rise slabs, which would have provided additional support. A kind of data storage platform for politics which, at the same time, was intended to communicate architecture as a cultural force and was to have an exemplary influence on the development of the city as a whole.

The quality of the site for the **Erste Bank Campus in Vienna** (for approximately 6,000 employees) – PAUHOF's most recent project – lies in its heterogeneity. Manifestations which are otherwise only to be found in peripheral parts of town converge here on representative central spaces of Vienna. The vast dimensions of the building site – as an exposed urban corner at the edge of a park – requires architecture that has the power to urbanise the site by re-defining its metamorphosis. We made precise use of scale discrepancies, the position as well as the diagonal ascent of a relief-like, gestural path set into the façade was dictated by the spatial situation behind it. Absolute priority was given to the interplay between the building structure and the users, building composition and context, flows of movement and the environment or infrastructure.




Erste Bank Campus, Vienna







Michael Hofstätter (born 1953) and Wolfgang Pauzenberger (born 1955) practice since 1986 as PAUHOF. The architectural firm PAUHOF draws up urbanistic studies, tackles architectural experiments, takes part in national and international competitions, modifies and designs exhibitions and builds architecture. The rigorous and radical architecture of Pauhof explores the paths of a critical minimalism and a basic abstraction, which are both quite close to conceptual art. With an approach that both strips down and intensifies the modernist vocabulary, Pauhof is in fact seeking a real formal independence of the architectural object. This object is released from all manner of stylistic, historical and contextual reference, and relieved of all manner of heteronomous determination, and as such is worked in a specific way and becomes just architecture. As a negative response to the excesses of Viennese postmodernism, this architectural self-reference is the very condition, for Pauhof, of a possible connection with the context, the city, and, above all, the subject summoned in its full power of perception.
